Aid in Comprehension

Explain how to properly wear a bicycle helmet to an 8 year old

What Goes Into the Model



- Each program is using different source material
 - All are proprietary so we don't know exactly what is being fed into them
- ChatGPT includes some combination of:
 - Web crawls
 - Links on Reddit
 - Books
 - Some published/some unpublished
 - Unclear which ones
 - English language Wikipedia
 - ALL source materials were published before 2021

Only As Good As What You Put Into the Model

The Model Depends on the Trainers



Example of Bias

Prompt:

"A wall in a royal castle. There are two paintings on the wall. The one on the left a detailed oil painting of the royal raccoon king. The one on the right a detailed oil painting of the royal raccoon queen."

Given only the direction to look royal, the raccoons are wearing western style royal outfits.

Limitations: Output



Accuracy Concerns

- Content that sounds good but is factually incorrect
 - Particularly dangerous if you don't know what the recommendations are yourself or if it makes claims that could lead to harm if people follow them.

• Fact check EVERYTHING!

Hallucinations

- Defined as "a confident response by an AI that does not seem to be justified by its training data"
- Example:
 - Inaccurate data: A chatbot with no knowledge of the number of firearm-related injuries in the US in 2023 might pick a number at random that it considers to be plausible and then continue to use that number repeatedly with no awareness that it made the number up and that it is not correct.
 - Fake citations: It makes up article names and journals that don't exist.

Proprietary Content

 Remember that anything you put into programs like ChatGPT become a part of their learning and can be accessed by <u>anyone</u>.

Don't put anything in there that you don't want out in the world.

Data Privacy Concerns

Are we setting ourselves up to have another Henrietta Lacks?

- Whose PHI are we using to train the models?
- Are we asking people if we can use their data?

We've already started seeing lawsuits regarding the use of people's biometric info being used for AI programs without their consent. (Clearview AI)

Where the Source Data Comes From

- Data scraped from other's creative work and used without their permission
 - True of text but also of the artwork/photography/music used for creating digital images and digital music
- Some examples of it spitting out content that is word-for-word from sites like Mayo Clinic but doesn't reference or cite it.
- If you don't know where the data comes from, it is harder to know where the biases are

Questions of Responsibility

- Who is responsible for Al mistakes and errors?
- Who is responsible for deciding where the plagiarism line is?

Hacking & Mis-/Dis-Information

- Hackers WILL figure out how to infiltrate these systems. What protections are in place?
- Mis-/Disinformation already in original data sources and can be trained into models. How will we stop that?

Even the Creators Don't Always Understand How They Work

What they thought they were training it to do	What the AI program actually did
Reduce the # of sorting errors in a list	Deleted the list (technically no more errors)
Play Tetris and not lose	It played the game and then hit the pause button on the game so it never finished (technically didn't lose)
Identify tumors and their size	Identified images with rulers in them
Identify people more likely to commit a crime by looking at previous arrest trends	Identified people more likely to be arrested not necessarily those more likely to commit a crime

Ways to Think About Use of Al

Use AI to help create "structure" while you create the content that goes in the structure

Think of AI like an intern or a copilot. It can get you 70% of the way there but you need to bring your voice & your expertise

Assume the data is wrong and fact check EVERYTHING

Invite a variety of people with different backgrounds to have a seat at the table

Preventing Bias and Discrimination

Do Your Research On All Third-Party Programs

Have a review process to ensure third-party programs/apps meet your standards on:

- Ethics
- Where the data comes from
- Security
- Data protection
- Bias reduction

Require Training

Many people don't understand how these programs work.

Training can teach employees to:

- To protect proprietary & confidential information
- To be aware of potential biases, potential for errors, ethical concerns, and more
